

Director's Note

'The theatre's empty. What? Have you gone home?'

In May 1991 I opened The Arches as a theatre space. Our very first production was *Noise and Smoky Breath* - featuring Glasgow poems and songs by Edwin Morgan from the book of the same name. I got in touch with Edwin to ask permission to stage some of his poems and he was happy to oblige. He visited The Arches a few times while I was there, and he always greeted me with that incredibly warm smile of his. Now, almost thirty years on, we present *high man pen meander*. The title of this work is a line from Edwin's poem *Pomander* which feels apt - this is a promenade show in which the audience will meander around our empty building.

We put a call out to artists to submit ideas for poems of their choosing. The universal appeal of Edwin's work is reflected by the range of artists who came forward with ideas - film makers, installation artists, drag artists, performance poets, street performers and actors. With no public allowed into our building, the camera becomes the audience being drawn along by an old Maître D' - down dark corridors to discover performers in waiting. Most of the pieces were devised by the artists themselves and our team have worked to create the feeling of a locked-up and blacked-out theatre building where we come across artists occupying spaces. Practising their crafts and constantly waiting and waiting for the lights to come back on...
